Our 2022 **Viognier** (vee-on-yay) is bursting with citrus and stone fruit. The grapes for this wine have been picked at a high sugar content which creates perceived sweetness despite being fermented to full dryness.

This aromatic smooth easy drinking **Semillon** (Sey-mee-on) expresses subtle peach and chamomile aromas. It has been put through a secondary ferment which compliments the flavour profile with a hint of butteriness.

2021 FILTERED PINOT NOIR

A unique **Pinot Noir** with fresh strawberry notes which are enhanced by a minimal addition of Viognier during the fermentation process. Filtered to create a highly clarified wine

2021 PEPPER SHIRAZ

This cool climate **Shiraz** packs plenty of punch thanks to the wonderful pepper it expresses. Made on site in 5 year old French oak barrels from grapes picked on the Bellarine Peninsula.

2021 BOLD SHIRAZ

This full bodied **Shiraz** is one to savour. The grapes for this wine were picked at extreme ripeness and left to age in French oak for 14 months. This process has helped the wine express rich, ripe, intense dark fruit flavours. Made on site from grapes picked in Great Western.

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ESTATE WINE

2022 ESTATE PINOT NOIR

Grown right here on the slopes of the Keayang Maar volcanic crater. Our free draining volcanic limestone soils and ultra cool climate have combined to produce a premium quality **Pinot Noir**. The 2022 vintage is considered the best seen here since vines were first planted with fruit quality at an exceptionally high level. The soils bring a beautiful vibrant acidity and soft tannins balanced with rich red fruit aromas and flavours that can only be achieved with the slow ripening that occurs in cool climate vineyards such as ours. This wine can be enjoyed now but also has great ageing potential.

2022 ESTATE SHIRAZ (SYRAH)

The grapes for this **Shiraz (Syrah)** have been carefully grown and selected from our vineyard on the slopes of the Keayang Maar volcanic crater. The 2022 vintage was possibly the best seen here in 20 years allowing our Syrah grapes to fully express the quality of our climate and soils. The delicate acidity and strong front end dark fruit flavours and aromas are beautifully balanced by maturation in french oak. Cellaring this Syrah for 5 years or more will reward.

Our Story



KEAYANG
MAAR

Keayang Maar Vineyard acknowledges the Yarro-Waech people of the Kirrai (Girae) Whurrong Nation, traditional custodians of the land on which we operate, live and gather. We recognise their continuing connection to land, water and community, and pay respect to their Elders past and present.

NAME

'Keayang Maar' comes from Keayang Estate - the original run of which the farm was part, post white settlement. The word Keayang comes from the traditional owners, the Yarro-Waech People and is understood to refer to freshwater fish or eel which are still found in the surrounding waterways. Maar is used in reference to the land formation, the low-lying volcanic crater which the vineyard overlooks.

FAMILY

Established in 2020, Keayang Maar Vineyard is owned and operated by the Wurlod Family, Bernadette & Barry and Caitlin & Jerram. Barry and Bernadette decided to expand their small hobby vineyard and build the cellar door in 2018. In 2019 youngest son Jerram and daughter-in-law, Caitlin came home from Melbourne with their young family, to join them in this new venture. There are currently four generations of the Wurlod family living on this farm.

FARM

Wallace (dec.) and Margeret Wurlod first moved to this property in the 1960s from Red Hill on the Mornington Peninsula. The family ran a successful dairy operation for two generations until Barry & Bernadette retired in the mid-2000s. At this stage, they subdivided a small section of the property and built their new home overlooking the Keayang Maar crater. The first vines were planted mostly for aesthetics, inspired by a trip to Europe in 2007. The Cellar Door was built during the pandemic in 2020 and opened in early 2021.

VINEYARD

Located on the side of a Volcanic crater, the grapevines at Keayang Maar Vineyard benefit from the region's cool climate, and unique volcanic soil profile and enjoy stunning views year-round.

We grow a variety of grapes on site with a focus on reds, Pinot Noir & Shiraz. There are also three white varieties Chardonnay, Riesling and Pinot Gris. The oldest vines have been in for 15 years. There are approximately 6 acres under vines currently and the vineyard is still expanding.

WINE

Winemaking first began on the slopes of Keayang Maar about ten years ago with owners Bernadette and Barry Wurlod. It started out of curiosity and soon developed into a (time consuming) hobby. With the return of the second generation the hobby developed into a passionate family partnership and commercial wine production started on site in 2020. Our wine is made from grapes picked on-site and at vineyards in the nearby Geelong wine region. Each wine tells a story that is unique to the vineyard - the soil profile, the location and the growing conditions. A portion of our wine was previously been made off-site in Geelong while our winery expanded. As of 2023 all wine is made on site by the Wurlod family at Dixie.
